CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dunbar called the Commission meeting to order at 7:30 pm on Wednesday, June 2, 2010.

Approval of Agenda: It was moved by Commissioner Margosis and seconded by Commissioner Margensey to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes: It was moved by Commissioner Margosis and seconded by Commissioner Margensey to approve the minutes from the April 21, 2010, meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Announcement: - The Commission welcomed Luis Padilla as a new Commissioner.

The Commission agreed to re-appoint Commissioner Solon to continue as the representative to the School Board Human Rights Advisory Commission.

Executive Director Saunders announced that the Student Human Rights Commission (SHRC) has held their year-end luncheon this afternoon. Commissioner Margosis keynoted the event. The SHRC will begin again in the fall.

Executive Director Saunders announced that the annual Virginia Association of Human Rights meeting will be held on Saturday, June 26, 2010, 9:00 am, at the Prince William County Government Center. This year's focus will be a legal update on religious discrimination provided by EEOC. Due to statewide budget constraints, this will be a half-day event. Lunch will be provided. All Commissioners are encouraged to attend.

Because of the changing members of the Commission, Executive Director Saunders recommended a mandatory training for at least the new Commissioners take place.

Commissioner Kwon recommended that the training be scheduled for a regularly scheduled meeting night with an open schedule. It was moved by Commissioner Margosis and seconded by Commissioner Selim that an annual mandatory training be scheduled. The motion passed with unanimous vote.

Staff Issues – Executive Director Saunders presented the April Case Report to the Commission. The agency continues to perform well above average for the month and remains on target with meeting the requirements of the Balanced Score Card.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Crawford reported that the Awards Ceremony went well. She congratulated the staff for their efforts in making the Awards Ceremony successful. HRC #2009429H – It was moved by Commissioner Crawford and seconded by Commissioner Solon that this complaint be dismissed due to a no cause finding. The motion passed with unanimous vote.
