CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Crawford called the Wednesday, December 2, 2015, Commission meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: It was moved by Commissioner Selim and seconded by Commissioner Margosis that the agenda be approved as presented. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: It was moved by Commissioner Selim and seconded by Commissioner Margosis that the November 18, 2015, minutes be approved as presented. The motion carried with unanimous vote.

STAFF ISSUES: There were no staff issues.

CLOSED SESSION: Commissioner Salinas moved that the Commission recess and go into closed session to consult with legal counsel, pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711 to discuss Tesfamikael v. Kim, HRC #2015102H/HUD #03-15-0438-8. Commissioner Solon seconded the motion. The motion carried with unanimous vote.

Commissioner Salinas moved to come out of closed session. Commissioner Selim seconded the motion. The motion carried with unanimous vote.

COMMISSION BUSINESS:

The County Attorney's office recommended that the Commissioners obtain county email accounts to be used for Commission business.

HRC #2015102H – FIR Reconsideration - It was moved by Commissioner Solon and seconded by Commissioner Margosis that there is sufficient evidence that a violation of the Human Rights Ordinance has occurred with respect to the national origin allegations in this matter. Commissioners Margosis, Brangman, Solon, Salinas voted in favor of the

motion. Commissioners Crawford, Shipman, and Selim voted against the motion. The motion passed with a majority vote.

HRC #2015142H – Conciliation Agreement – It was moved by Commissioner Solon and seconded by Commissioner Brangman that the conciliation agreement in this matter be accepted as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

HRC #2015150H – Conciliation Agreement – It was moved by Commissioner Margosis and seconded by Commissioner Salinas that the conciliation agreement in this matter be accepted as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

COMMUNITY CONCERNS: Commissioner Margosis was recently in the Washington Post with respect to an article about immigration.

PENDING BUSINESS: There was no pending business.

NEW BUSINESS: Christine Todd, President and CEO of Northern Virginia Association of Realtors (NVAR), is retiring. It was moved by Commissioner Salinas and seconded by Commissioner Margosis that Ms. Todd be recognized by the Human Rights Commission with a plaque of appreciation for her support and for all she has done for the Fairfax County Fair Housing Task Force and the Fairfax County Student Human Rights Commission. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
