



Accotink Stream Valley to Oak Marr




Pickett Road/Blake Lane/Jermantown Road

THE PICKETT ROAD/BLAKE LANE/JERMANTOWN ROAD TRAIL

is part of the countywide trail plan. It is also a component of the Cross County Trail which stretches across the county from south to north. It links the Occoquan River in the south to the Potomac River at Great Falls National Park. The trail runs through the Laurel Hill Greenway and the Pohick Creek, Accotink Creek and Difficult Run Stream Valleys.

This portion of the trail runs on sidewalks along public roads, connecting to the trail through Thaiss Park and Accotink Stream Valley and to the asphalt trail along the eastern property line of Oak Marr Park. There is parking at Thaiss Park off

Pickett Road and at Oak Marr Park. Facilities at Oak Marr include a RECenter, golf course and driving range, miniature golf course, and ballfields. Restroom facilities are available at the RECenter. This trail segment is concrete sidewalk with a section of asphalt trail in Oak Marr Park.

There are at-grade road crossings with pedestrian signal lights at Route 50, Route 29, Five Oaks Road, Sutton Road, Blake Lane/Jermantown Road, and Route 123. The trail crosses Route 66 on the sidewalk along the bridge on Blake Lane. The distance from Pickett Road to the end of the paved trail in Oak Marr is approximately 3.2 miles.
