1. Email and phone requests will be taken for stall(s), and pre-ordered bedding. **Phone number - 703-437-9101 ext 301 or [chris.monson@fairfaxcounty.gov](mailto:chris.monson@fairfaxcounty.gov)**
2. Requests for stalls and pre-ordered bedding shall not be considered CONFIRMED until payment is received.
3. Checks should be made payable to "FRYING PAN PARK" in the amount of the total number of stalls requested (horse + tack stalls) multiplied by the stall fee; and/or the total number bags of pre-ordered bedding multiplied by the fee per bag;. The check memo line should indicate the total number of stalls and bags of bedding.
4. Mail checks to Frying Pan Park, 2709 West Ox Rd, Herndon, VA 20171
5. Reservations will be recorded first come, first served - based upon date of post office mark.
6. Checks WILL BE CASHED when received.
7. Stalls and pre-ordered bedding checks will be cashed if reservation is a "no show".

If you wish to be stalled with someone or a certain group we will be most happy to accommodate you if reservation and payments are sent in together. If you plan on paying when you arrive you will be processed and assigned stalls accordingly.
