## **Frying Pan Farm Park and Clifton Saddlery Justin Hise**

### **Handy Hunter Classic Rules:**

In January 2008 Frying Pan Farm Park lost one its most dedicated, hard working, enduring employees: Justin Hise. In his honor Frying Pan Farm Park has started the Justin Hise Hunter Classic. This class is a memorial dedication to recognize his hard work and efforts in making Frying Pan Farm Park what it is today.


The Handy Hunter Classic is open to all. There will be two classes, a 2ft and 2ft 6in, however, riders may not cross enter into both classes. The classic will be scored as a one-round Hunter Classic over a hunter-type course of at least (8) fences, then a flat phase will follow. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. The class will be judged with 75% of score over fences, 25% under saddle. All entries must show in at least one full division (at fence heights of 2' or higher) at each show to be eligible for the Hunter Classic. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.

Class 36 and 44 Entry fee \$20.00. **No pre-entry discount**

- ◆ Points for the Handy Hunter Classic only, will be 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2.
- ◆ Points to the horse/pony/rider combination.
- ◆ Horses may not cross enter.
- ◆ Competitors points will be posted at Clifton Saddlery for all to follow.
- ◆ The horse/pony/rider accumulating the most points in the Handy Hunter Classic throughout the seven shows will win \$300. Places 2nd thru 6th will win prizes money, \$175, \$125, \$100, \$75, \$50.

## Show Rules


1. This show is an associate member of the VHSA. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current VHSA rule book will be conducted and judged accordingly. The November 5th show is not a VHSA Associate rated show. We will run the same show schedule, but no points to VHSA.
2. All entries must show a current negative Coggins test (taken within 12 months) before a number will be issued.
3. **All shows will follow the new VHSA point system. VHSA points based on 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5. Champion 10, reserve 6.**
4. Class fees are \$15 each day of show. Pre-register at [www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/fpp](http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/fpp) and class fees are \$12 per class. Pre-registrations must be received by 3pm the Friday before show to be eligible for the discount.
5. Keep and use the same back number for all the shows. Use of the same back number will stream line the entry process. Just fill out the entry sheet with your back number and classes you want to enter and you're done. It is the riders responsibility to keep and maintain the back number. Replacement numbers may be purchased for \$5 each. No number will be issued unless all fees have been paid or a signed check is left with entry form.
6. **Entry fees will not be refunded for a class once that class has begun. If you need to scratch a class, you must do so 1 class prior to that class. Failure to scratch 1 class prior, no refund will be given. Any class shown in and not entered before the class starts will be charged the entry fee plus a \$10.00 office charge.**
7. All equitation classes will be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control. Tests per VHSA rules.
8. Frying Pan Park, the Fairfax County Park Authority, Founders, Benefactors, Supervisors, Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park, their employees, and volunteers will not be responsible for any accident, injury or loss occurring during the shows. Exhibitors enter the shows under this condition.
9. There will be six ribbons in all classes. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded in each division.
10. Entries showing "unjudged" will be limited to the end of the class, if time permits. Unjudged entries pay the same entry fee for each round.
11. At the option of management, a dotted line may be enforced.
12. A three minute gate call will be given for all classes. If no rider enters the ring when the class is called during the three minute time period, the class will be cancelled. Entry fees will still be assessed for the cancelled class.
13. Hard hats are required at all times while mounted. Juniors must wear safety helmets with approved (USEF or USPC) harness fastened.
14. Judge's decisions are final.
15. **Each class must have at least 2 entries to be held and three entries must complete the class for VHSA points to count.**
16. Proper attire required in all classes.
17. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes if necessary.
18. Exhibitors do not have to be VHSA members to show in all classes. VHSA information will be available if you wish to join at the show.
19. A \$25 fee will be charged on returned checks.
20. Judges to be determined. Please check our web site for updates @ [www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/fpp](http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/fpp).

## Award Rules

1. Frying Pan Farm Park employees are not eligible for awards.
2. All riders must declare their age in the appropriate box on the entry form. This is the exhibitor's responsibility. Undeclared riders will not be eligible.
3. Juniors, amateurs and professionals are defined by USEF rules.
4. Awards to be offered at the seven shows are included in this prize list.
5. In the event of a tie, a coin toss will determine the winner.

### **Frying Pan Farm Park Grand High Point Awards**

Frying Pan Farm Park will offer grand high point awards to the riders having the highest accumulated score throughout the entire seven shows. All points accumulated in any class count towards year end awards. This includes warm-up classes and equitation classes. Hunter Classic points do not count towards Grand High Point Awards. Points based on 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2, Champion 10 points, Reserve 6 points

12 and under Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket  
13 - 17 Grand High Point: Embroidered cooler  
13 - 17 Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket

18 and over Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket

### **Division Awards**

There will be Champion and Reserve Champion year-end high point division awards in all divisions with three classes. In order to qualify for year end division awards, entries must show in three out of the seven shows. Points are based on - 1st place 10pts, 2nd place 6pts, 3rd place 4pts, 4th place 2pt, 5th place 1pt and 6th place 1/2pt - Champion 10pts, Reserve 6pts.
