Job Title: Horticultural Intern

The intern will work in a variety of garden spaces, and may choose from projects involving horticulture, curation, propagation, community horticulture or education that suits the mission and activities at Green Spring Gardens. Potential projects for 2015 are: propagation; working with plant records; developing interpretive signs; and planning special programs.

This internship is generously funded by the Friends of Green Spring (FROGS).

Compensation: Interns will be temporary, part-time employees of the Fairfax County Park Authority. Compensation is \$10.46/hour for up to 300 hours. Start and end dates are negotiable.

Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four year horticulture, botany, environmental education or similar degree program.
