



# Green Spring Gardens Horticulture Internship Announcement Summer 2012

- Job Title:** Horticultural Intern
- Description:** Green Spring Gardens is a 31-acre public garden with 1784 Historic House that offers themed gardens for enjoyment, education and inspiration.
- The intern may choose from projects involving horticulture, curation, propagation, community horticulture or education that suits the mission and activities at Green Spring Gardens. Potential projects for 2012 are: propagation; working with plant records; developing interpretive signs; and planning special programs.
- Compensation:** Interns will be temporary, part-time employees of the Fairfax County Park Authority. Compensation is \$10.46/hour for up to 300 hours. Start and end dates are negotiable.
- Requirements:** Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four year horticulture, botany, environmental education or similar degree program. Internship responsibilities include developing a project proposal, conducting project activities and presenting a written and oral project report.
