Propagation and Rock Garden Intern Announcement

Job Title: Horticultural Intern—Propagation Area and Rock Garden

Description: Green Spring Gardens is a 31-acre public garden with 1784 Historic House that offers themed gardens for enjoyment, education and inspiration.

The intern will assist the Propagation team with a variety of tasks including the maintenance of several garden areas, a large Rock Garden and a conservatory. The intern will develop his or her knowledge of how to care for a rock garden as well as learn the types of plants that will thrive there. Additional responsibilities include propagation—cuttings and seeds, working with volunteers, and caring for the plant shop and nursery.

The internship is generously funded by the Friends of Green Spring (FROGS) and the Potomac Valley Chapter of the North American Rock Garden Society.

Compensation: Interns will be temporary, part-time employees of the Fairfax County Park Authority. Compensation is \$10.46/hour for up to 300 hours. Start and end dates are negotiable.

Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four year horticulture, botany, environmental education or similar degree program.
