

INTERPRETIVE SIGN 2: THEN AND NOW

Male narrator:

The next interpretive sign is titled "The Battlefield of Chantilly: Then and Now. It shows the lay of the land, where the condos and townhomes now sit in front of you, as it was in the early 20th century. You can get a sense of what the area was like at the time of the Civil War. The land looked much like the land in this photo on the day of the battle. If you face the sign, you could be in a Confederate uniform, looking at Stevens' forces attacking, coming toward you. The cornfield that concealed you and your fellow Confederates extended to your right and behind you. There were more Confederates to your left and behind you, where Monument Drive is now.
