Now, there is **Starlight Cinema**. The Fairfax County Park Authority has revived the fun of drive-in movies for a new generation.

Relive the old-fashioned enjoyment of the drive-in Saturday evenings this August. Your evening will begin at 7:30 P.M. with an outdoor pre-movie program – music, food and children's activities. Then, at dark, the movies will start. Admission is free and the event is appropriate for the entire family. Gate opens at 6:00 P.M.

Directions: From the Capital Beltway take Exit 49 West (I-66 west) to Exit 53A south (Sully Road, VA-28, south) towards Centreville to merge onto Lee Highway (Rt. 29) to right onto Trinity Parkway into the parking lot in front of the Trinity Office Building.

Saturday, August 1 **MADAGASCAR: ESCAPE 2 AFRICA**
