JUNE 28, 2016 PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

MEETING SUMMARY

A public meeting was held at the Sully Government Center on June 28, 2016 to introduce the community to the master plan revision process for Ellanor C. Lawrence Park. The meeting convened at 7:00 pm and was facilitated by Sandy Stallman, Manager of the Park Planning Branch, Fairfax County Park Authority. Supervisor Kathy Smith and Board Member Maggie Godbold welcomed the public and spoke of the importance of Ellanor C. Lawrence Park and its importance not only to the local community, but to the County and region as a whole through the Sully Woodlands planning initiative.
