Park Authority to Begin Nottoway Park Field Improvements

The Fairfax County Park Authority will begin constructing improvements at Nottoway Park on the exiting 60-foot diamond field in June. Field #5 at the 84-acre park located in Vienna, will become the first synthetic turf diamond field in the Fairfax County Park Authority system.

The contractor, General Sports Venue of Raleigh, North Carolina will be moving on site in the next few weeks. Construction access to the site will be from the park entrance off Courthouse Road. Project completion is scheduled for September 2008.

This project is part of the ongoing efforts by Fairfax County to meet the growing need for athletic fields countywide. Synthetic turf fields provide increased player capacity, availability regardless of weather and reduced maintenance requirements. Project funding and support has been provided by the 2006 Park Bond and Providence District proffer funding.
