Park Authority Acquires Parcels Adjacent to Lincoln Lewis-Vannoy

The Fairfax County Park Authority has acquired 25.6 acres of new parkland adjacent to Lincoln Lewis-Vannoy Park in Fairfax. These two parcels, known as the Buckley properties, will increase the park size to just over 67 acres. The properties will expand this community park located at 12410 Braddock Road in Centreville. Future amenities and park use will be determined in the future through the public park planning process.

Springfield District Supervisor Pat Herrity said of the acquisition, “This property will make a great place for additional fields, which along with the development of Patriot Park will go a long way in helping to solve our shortage of fields for our youth and adult sports groups.”

The parcels contain a few small and historically non-significant structures and an old house. These will be removed. However, a small cemetery on the property containing five to eight graves will be preserved.

The property was acquired at a cost of \$1.3 million. The acquisition is significant in that it provides new strategically located recreational space in a district where recreationally amenities are at a premium and demand for these facilities is high.
