Final Resident Curator Program Study to Be Presented

The Resident Curator Program Study, prepared by John Milner Associates, Inc. will be presented to the public at a meeting on October 23, 2014 at 7 p.m. in Rooms 4/5 of the Government Center located at 12000 Government Center Parkway in Fairfax, Va. The final report is available for review online at www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/plandev/downloads/resident-curator-program-final-report.pdf. The meeting will feature a presentation on the report findings and there will be an opportunity for the public to ask questions regarding the study.

The Fairfax County Board of Supervisors directed Park Authority and Department of Planning and Zoning staff to work with the Fairfax County History Commission to evaluate how a resident curator program would work in the county.

Resident curator programs have been used to preserve and protect historically significant buildings in jurisdictions across the United States and the county is exploring the use of such a program in Fairfax County.
