Community Meeting Set to Discuss Improvements to Eakin Park

The Fairfax County Park Authority will hold a community meeting to discuss improvements at the Eakin Community Park on Thursday, December 4, 2014 at 7 p.m. This meeting will focus on potential improvements at the Prosperity Road entrance as well as a proposal to add a picnic pavilion near the Tobin Road entrance. The meeting will take place at Mantua Elementary School cafeteria. The school is located at 9107 Horner Court in Fairfax, Va.

Eakin Community Park was established as the first county park in the 1950s and '60s and is surrounded by the expansive Accotink Stream Valley Park. The Gerry Connolly Cross County Trail and extensive natural areas are major features of these parks as well as ball fields, tennis courts, playground and garden plots.

The meeting will include a staff briefing on the proposals and opportunity for public discussion and questions.
