## Green Spring Gardens Renews Winter Lecture Series

The Harry Allen Winter Lecture Series is underway at Green Spring Gardens in Alexandria, Va. This year's topics in the annual series include Smithsonian garden archives, a search for the best plants, peonies, plants for shade, garden photography, the gardening life of author Beatrix Potter, early spring containers and conservation.

The lectures, which bring authors and experts on the cutting edge of garden research to the park, begin at 1:30 p.m. and run until 3 p.m. on select Sundays into March.
