The Fairfax County Park Authority offers a wide array of summer camp programs, including fishing, sports and nature camps that cater to teens 13 years and older. Camps are a great place to explore new hobbies, learn new skills and interact with other kids the same age. Camps also provide a safe place for teens to spend their summer days while parents are at work.

Your children have the chance to get interested in a new sport or try their hand at one of the many outdoor adventures. Whatever your teen chooses, they're sure to have a fun-filled day and make connections with others their age.

If you have a teen 16 or 17 years old, they might enjoy one of our Junior Golf camps, Nature Photography & Hiking programs, Paddle & Explore series or Fly Fishing adventures.

These camps are a sampling of those catering to teens up to age 15 years of age: Camp SheEO for Entrepreneurs, Circus Arts, Gymnastics & Dance, Cheerleading, Fishing Adventures and Archery.

And for those younger teens, these camps are a few that offer activities for kids up to 13 or 14 years of age: Wilderness Survival, British Soccer Player Development, Movie Making, Archeology, Tennis, Robotics, Skateboarding, Mountain Biking, Lacrosse, Adventure and Theme Park Adventures, Instructional Basketball, Chess, Junior Lifeguarding.

Some camps are available for younger children as well. You'll find many of our RECenters, parks, nature centers and historic sites offer an array of camps each session. This allows parents the convenience to register more than one child at a single location. Don't forget to check out our extended care listing for sites offering before and after care services.
