Park Authority Board Elects 2015 Officers

The Fairfax County Park Authority Board elected their 2015 officers in action taken at their January 28, 2015, meeting. Returning for his seventh term as Chairman is William G. Bouie, who represents the Hunter Mill District on the Board. Providence District Representative Ken Quincy was elected to serve as Vice Chairman. At-large member Kala Leggett Quintana will serve as Board Secretary and Sully District Representative Harold Strickland returns to the leadership team as Treasurer.

Chairman Bouie joined the Park Authority in 2005. He is currently the President and CEO of Sky Communications Inc. Chairman Bouie is an active volunteer involved in myriad civic ventures and organizations. Service highlights include a leadership position with Little League Baseball of Northern Virginia; positions on the board of Wolf Trap Center for the Performing Arts; Public Links, Inc., the Reston Community Center Board of Governors; Reston Hospital Center Board of Trustees; and the Initiative for Public Art Reston (IPAR).

Vice Chairman Quincy has been a member of the Park Authority Board since 2007. Most recently he has been a key advocate for transforming Tysons by including parks beginning with his participation in the Tysons Task Force. He helped in ensuring that parks were a key component in the new vision and plan for Tysons and that FCPA was included in the discussions about the future of Tysons. He also chairs the Park Planning and Development Committee.

Secretary Quintana, a longtime resident of Burke, was first appointed to the Park Authority Board as an at-large member in October 2010. She is a communications and public affairs professional with a strong focus on public service. She also serves as chair of the Park Services Committee and the Strategic Planning and Initiatives Committee.

Harold Strickland is a veteran member of the Park Board serving since 1992. He has been at the forefront of enormous service expansion and unique challenges and has served as chairman of the Park Authority Board six times over the years. This selection returns him to service as a member of the Executive Committee.
