Park Authority Announces Selection of New Chief of Business Development

Ms. Aimee Long Vosper has been named Deputy Director, Chief of Business Development for the Fairfax County Park Authority, a position that will focus on the creation and expansion of partnerships essential to the agency’s financial stability. She will also oversee the Park Authority’s planning and development initiatives, strategic planning efforts and the Automated Services Branch. She begins her service with the agency on February 23, 2015.

Ms. Vosper currently serves as Director of Environmental & Planning Services at the Northern Virginia Regional Commission (NVRC) where she represents 14 Northern Virginia governments as a member of the Virginia Association of Planning District Commissions. She has extensive experience with local, state and regional governments as well as international governments on the development of business/government relationships to promote beneficial partnerships and agreements. Her leadership experience includes collaborative work advancing, green development - the ‘Natural Capital’ of the future, community energy planning and smart growth, environmental, heritage and cultural resources planning, multi-modal transportation, climate change adaptation, land conservation, capital projects, water quality, land use, land negotiations, and planning.

Previous to her work with NVRC, she worked with the City of Alexandria, VA as Division Chief of Parks and Capital Projects. During her decade of service to Alexandria she developed policy and briefing papers, created outreach strategies and worked as a liaison with other jurisdictions. Her role in city government was considered essential to the development of partnerships both internally and externally. She also worked as a senior landscape architect and planner for Sikand Engineering and Planning in Los Angeles California prior to her work with Alexandria.

She is a graduate of North Carolina State College of Design where she earned a Bachelor’s of Environmental Design in Landscape Architecture. Vosper has taught engineering and design at George Washington University.
