Community Meeting To Inform Residents Set

CCT Improvements to Impact Lake Accotink Park Trails

The Fairfax County Park Authority will begin working on improvements to the Cross County Trail (CCT) in Lake Accotink Park within the next month. A Public Information Meeting to discuss the project is slated for Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at 7 p.m. The meeting will be held in the cafeteria at Kings Park Elementary School located at 5400 Harrow Way, in Springfield, VA.

The project will pave the trail from Braddock Road to a point approximately 5,200 feet south. An existing trail connection to Danbury Forest will be paved as well. A new bridge will replace the existing wooden bridge approximately 150 feet south of Braddock Road. This \$378,000 project is funded by Park Bonds.

The contractor, Accubid Construction Services, Inc., will be mobilizing on site within the next month. Contingent upon the weather, this project will continue for 180 days.

Construction access to the site will be from the Ellet Road entrance to the park. Every effort will be made to keep as many sections of trail open at any one time, however, portions may be closed to users during the project.
