Sully Hosts 42nd Annual Antique Car Show on Father's Day

Sunday, June 21, 2015 marks the 42nd anniversary of the Sully Antique Car Show, co-hosted by the Fairfax County Park Authority and the George Washington Chapter Model A Ford Club of America. Between 10 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., bring dad to this historic show featuring foreign and American cars, trucks and specialty vehicles through 1990. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$8 for seniors and \$6 for children. Free parking is available on site.

More than 400 antique and classic vehicles fill Sully's grounds at the largest car show in northern Virginia. Trophies and plaques will be awarded in all classes at the end of the day. You can purchase the car of your dreams at the Car Corral and watch a Model T take-apart demonstration. Find the perfect gift or treat yourself with a car accessory, craft or antique in the Flea Market. Over 50 vendors are expected.

Rock 'n' roll to music of the 50s with Jumpin' Jupiter and enjoy traditional vocal and instrumental bluegrass with the Andrew Acosta Band. Enjoy a delicious lunch or snack from our food court or buy a snow cone and support the Model A Ford Club.

At the children's tent, our younger visitors can "drive" mini vehicles in our corn kernel sand box and special auto-themed coloring books have been created just for this show. Kids can create their own paper sun hat.

Included in admission is a guided tour of the first floor of the 1794 home of Richard Bland Lee, Northern Virginia's first congressman. See the original 18th century open hearth kitchen that was converted into a garage in the 1950s and an exhibit chronicling the evolution of the automobile. Vehicles from Sully's past are featured in the photos.
