## Lake Fairfax Trout Fishing Passes Are Now On Sale

Local trout fishermen are gathering their tackle and preparing for the trout fishing season at Lake Fairfax Park in Reston, Va. The 20-acre lake will be stocked with thousands of pounds of safe-to-eat rainbow trout multiple times between February 14 and May 3, 2015. A variety of passes are now available for purchase at the park.

### Daily Pass

- Adult \$15
- Senior \$10
- Child \$7.50

### Spring Pass

- Adult \$60
- Senior \$45
- Child \$30

### Fall Pass

- Adult \$22
- Senior \$17
- Child \$12

### Year Pass (includes fall season, October 10 through November 8)

- Adult \$70
- Senior \$52.50
- Child \$35

A Virginia fishing license is required along with either a one-day or a seasonal trout fishing pass available at the site. There are one-pole and six-fish limits. The lake is accessible for shoreline fishermen.
