Hidden Oaks Offers Half-day Camps for Young Naturalists

Preschoolers’ creativity and imagination soar at half-day camps this June at Hidden Oaks Nature Center. Naturalists explore the woodlands and stream with children ages three to five years old making personal connections with turtles, toads and salamanders. Through short hikes, crafts, games and songs these youngest explorers enjoy connecting to nature during the first week of June.

During the second and third weeks of June, preschoolers age four to six re-create recreate storybook fun as they attend Miss Spider’s tea party and a Teddy Bear picnic. Using treasured tales for a background, naturalist-led children make the characters of the fables come alive as they meet a real hungry caterpillar and a not-so-quiet cricket at Tea Parties, Picnics and Storybooks camp.
