## Leave No Trace Workshop Coming to Scott's Run

The Leave No Trace outdoor skills and ethics program is coming to Scott's Run Nature Preserve. The Fairfax County Park Authority will host a Leave No Trace Workshop at the park beginning at 9 a.m. on Sunday, August 30, 2015.

During the two-hour class, participants become acquainted with the program which was established by The Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics. This session will include an introduction to the seven principles of Leave No Trace: Know Before You Go, Choose the Right Path, Trash Your Trash, Leave What You Find, Be Careful With Fire, Respect Wildlife, and Be Kind To Other Visitors.

The skills taught in the workshop apply to all outdoor enthusiasts and to all environments.

This program is designed for youth 8 to 18 years old. The cost is \$6 for Fairfax County residents and \$8 for out-of-county visitors. Scott's Run Nature Preserve is located at 7400 Georgetown Pike in McLean, Va. Participants will meet at the nature preserve's west entrance. There are no facilities in the park.
