## Learn About Slave Life at Sully Historic Site

Slaves once lived and worked in Fairfax County, and Sully Historic Site is offering a glimpse into what their lives would have been like as a new nation was being formed.

On Saturday, November 7, 2015, Sully is hosting a program at the site's slave quarter to help today's residents learn how slaves spent their days and sample some of their chores. From 1 to 3 p.m., visitors can make a hoe cake, card wool and fill a pin cushion, and use a draw knife to work with wood. The program also includes a tour of the slave quarter and the original outbuildings at Sully.

This program is suitable for those ages five to adult. The cost is \$10 per person.
