Equestrian Center Entrance Drive in Laurel Hill to Be Relocated

Those who love to hike, bike, walk, run or ride horses at the Laurel Hill Equestrian Center in southern Fairfax County are going to need to take new road to get there.

The Fairfax County Lorton Road Widening project in Laurel Hill is starting a new phase of construction that will realign the Equestrian Center Entrance Road. Effective immediately, equestrians will no longer be able to access the Equestrian Center directly off of Lorton Road. The new entrance drive will be located on the newly realigned Furnace Road. There will be signage put in place to direct users to the new permanent entrance location.
