## Celebrate 50 Years of the National Historic Preservation Act

Fairfax County will commemorate 50 years of the National Historic Preservation Act with a symposium on Saturday, April 16, 2016 on “Setting the Stage for Local Preservation.”

The symposium at the James Lee Center will look at the history of the National Historic Preservation Act and how its passage enabled the development of historic preservation efforts nationally, regionally and locally. This event is free and open to all who are interested in historic preservation.

Former Sully District Supervisor Michael Frey will kick things off with introductory remarks. The featured speakers for the event will be Ronald D.
