## New Lake Accotink Loop Connector Trail Opens at Danbury Forest Drive

A ribbon-cutting ceremony is scheduled for Saturday, October 29, 2016, at 10 a.m. for the Lake Accotink Park Danbury Forest Drive Trail Connector in Springfield, Virginia.

This new \$104,000 trail provides a connection to the very popular Lake Accotink Loop trail and is designed to enhance safety for users. The eight-foot wide asphalt trail runs for 270 linear feet and replaces an old connector that was narrow, steep and in extremely poor condition. The new trail was rerouted to reduce slopes from 30 percent to less than 15 percent.

The Fairfax County Park Authority project was designed in cooperation with the Danbury Forest Community Association and built by McGee Civil Construction, LLC, of Purcellville, Virginia. Funding was provided by the 2012 Park Bond. Required easements for the project were provided by the Danbury Forest Community Association.

A brief ribbon cutting ceremony will be held at the intersection of Danbury Forest Drive and Uxbridge Court in Springfield, Va. Light refreshments will follow.
