Take a Special Tour of Historic Huntley at Twilight Time

Historic Huntley sits high upon a hill overlooking Hybla Valley and Huntley Meadows Park – a dramatic setting made more stunning by the setting sun.

Share in this special time at the 19th-century architectural gem with an after-hours tour on Friday, April 15, 2016, that allows you to see the house in a different light. Over the years, Historic Huntley was used as a summer retreat, grain farm, and an encampment for the troops of the 3rd Michigan Infantry during the Civil War. It was eventually converted to a dairy farm but later abandoned. See the restored house and learn about its history during this program for adults from 7 to 8 p.m. Enjoy light refreshments after your tour, and dress for the weather. The cost is \$6 per person.
