Slip into White Gloves for a Special Museum Collections Tour

Museum collections offer a peek into the past and tell stories of the people who once used the objects being preserved. Get up close and personal with items from the Sully Historic Site collection on the Behind the Scenes, White Glove Tour on Sunday, April 24, 2016.

The main house at Sully was completed in 1799 and reveals much about Fairfax County’s past. The house was built by Richard Bland Lee, Northern Virginia’s first Representative to Congress, and combines aspects of Georgian and Federal architecture. On this tour, you’ll have a chance to go behind the scenes and learn about the families who once lived at Sully through the objects they used.

This tour is appropriate for participants age eight to adult and runs from 1 to 2 p.m. The cost is \$8 per person. White gloves are provided!
