Experience the Beauty of Historic Southern Maryland

Head south with the Fairfax County Park Authority to historic Southern Maryland. Get away on Thursday, May 26, 2016 with historian Eric Malmgren and enjoy a beautiful and historic excursion. Begin with a visit to the quaint, riverside town of Leonardtown where Tudor Hall, a 1744 Georgian mansion home with unique features is located. Then travel to lovely Sotterley Plantation, the only tidewater plantation in Maryland open to the public. Designated a National Historic Landmark in 2000, Sotterley is older than Mount Vernon with a history that spans three centuries.

This trip includes a moderate walk, lunch and admission to the historic sites. The motor coach will leave Ellanor C. Lawrence Park at 10 a.m. and return at 5 p.m. This trip is for adults 18 years and older. The cost is \$77/\$92 per person
