Enjoy Parks by Night with Campfire Program and a Frog Chorus

There's a lot happening in Fairfax County parks after people go home for the day. Get nighttime access to the parks at two different programs this Saturday, May 14. This is an opportunity to look and listen for the animals that call the parks home 24/7.

Meet a naturalist at Eakin Community Park in Fairfax for a walk to the pond where you can enjoy a frog chorus. Learn to identify frogs by sound and features from 7:30 to 9 p.m. The walk is designed for those age four to adult, and the cost is \$7 per person. Children must be accompanied by an adult registered in the program. Participants should bring one flashlight per family. This event will be canceled in the event of rain. At Lake Accotink Park, adventure awaits as you explore the woodlands with a naturalist and check out the spots where wildlife hides and resides. This program is for participants age three to adult and runs from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Wrap up the evening with a cozy campfire and bring along whatever you would like to roast. S'mores are provided.
