Prehistoric Symposium Coming to Fairfax County

There have been folks making history in the mid-Atlantic for thousands of years. Before that, nature was producing its own style of history book, and there's an upcoming opportunity for you to read a few pages of it. The Friends of Fairfax County Archaeology and Cultural Resources and the Fairfax County Park Authority are hosting a Prehistoric Symposium on May 21, 2016, at the James Lee Community Center in Annandale, Va.

Speakers at the program include archaeologists from the Fairfax County Park Authority, the Pennsylvania State Museum, and North Carolina State University. Topics include geologic mid-Atlantic prehistory and excavations of coastal sites in Maryland, Old Colchester and Sully Woodlands in Fairfax County, Paleoindian sites in the Shenandoah Valley, and at Virginia's Smith Mountain Lake.

The symposium runs from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The James Lee Center is located at 2855 Annandale Road in Fairfax, Va.
