Hidden Oaks Nature Center is hosting a Fairy Tale Tea Time for participants age four and older. Fairy tales will come to life as you sip tea and enjoy treats surrounded by your favorite fairy tale characters. You can dress as your favorite character and learn why so many fairy tales include our animal friends. The program runs from 2 to 3:30 p.m., and the cost is \$15 per person. Children must be accompanied by an adult registered in the program.

Sample two ryes and three bourbons along with light hors d'oeuvres. The program runs from 4 to 6 p.m., and the cost is \$42 per person.
