Discover the “Grey Ghost” at the Frying Pan Meeting House

Frying Pan Fridays at Frying Pan Farm Park continue with a Civil War talk about the Grey Ghost himself, John Singleton Mosby, on October 21, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. Mosby was a Confederate Army cavalry battalion commander in the Civil War. His command, the 43rd Battalion, Virginia Cavalry, known as *Mosby's Rangers* or *Mosby's Raiders*, was known for its lightning-quick raids and its ability to elude Union Army pursuers.

The fun takes place at the historic Frying Pan Meeting House, which dates from 1791. Other ghost stories are also on the slate. The program lasts 90 minutes, including a hands-on activity, a short hike, s'mores and a campfire. The event is for ages five and up and is \$8 per person. Dress appropriately for cooler outside temperatures.
