

Scout Merit Badges Mount Vernon RECenter

Communication Merit Badge

We will complete all the requirements for the Communication merit badge in this session except for requirement #8, serving as master of ceremony for your troop campfire, court of honor or worship service. We will go through the requirement and send you home with some examples that you can use.

Disability Awareness Merit Badge

We will complete all the requirements for this merit badge. Please come prepared to swim, as some of our disability activities will be in the pool.

Emergency Preparedness Merit Badge

The first requirement for this merit badge is having earned the First Aid merit badge. If you have already done this, please bring your merit badge card or award card. Otherwise the merit badge will be an incomplete for requirement #1 and your scoutmaster can fill it in.

Requirement 2C requires you to share information with your family. Your troop will be able to sign this final requirement for you, or the merit badge counsellor at Mount Vernon can do it after you complete it.

Environmental Science

All the requirements for this merit badge will be completed. Please come prepared to be outside most of the day. Wear long pants, boots and bring water.

First Aid

All the requirements for this merit badge will be completed.

Sustainability

You will need to do requirement #1 with your family before attending.

“Before starting work on any other requirements for this merit badge, write in your own words the meaning of sustainability. Explain how you think conservation and stewardship of our natural resources relate to sustainability. Have a family meeting, and ask family members to write down what they think sustainability means. Be sure to take notes. You will need this information again for requirement 5.”

You will be sent home with several things to do with your family. Once they are completed, either your troop leader or the merit badge counsellor can sign them on your blue card. These include requirement 2 : Water – A , Food – A, Stuff – A and B, and requirement 5.
