The Centreville Planning Study is an opportunity to **update the county's policies for future growth** in the area.



WHAT IS THIS THE CENTREVILLE PLANNING STUDY?

In Fall of 2022 the Board of Supervisors authorized county planning staff to identify new Plan priorities and advance inclusive community engagement.



WHY CENTREVILLE? WHY NOW?

Current Plan priorities were crafted over 30 years ago. Centreville is one of the few remaining community centers to have not been reviewed since that time.

WHY DOES IT MATTER TO ME?


The Plan includes county and community goals and guides the type and location of future development in the area and how intense the development might be.





WHAT IS THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN?

Staff began work in early 2023 focusing on building a public engagement strategy, stakeholder identification, gaining an understanding of the community, and evaluating existing conditions in the area.










