





Land Use Updates



Environment Committee – Met on May 26th to update the Planning Commission on the outcome of the presentation to the Board of Supervisors on the MITRE Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Report and to continue review of the MITRE Building Energy Technology Recommendations.

Land Use Process Review Committee – Met on April 14th, and May 18th to discuss the Fairfax Forward program and the regulatory improvement efforts of the Economic Success Strategic Plan assessment conducted by Gartner, Inc.

Policy and Procedures Committee-Met on May 5th to review and comment on the proposed 2016 Zoning Ordinance Work Program and receive an update on the status of the PDC/PRM District Amendment.

Schools Committee – Met on April 20th, May 4th, May 25th, June 15th, and June 29th to discuss the proposed Urban/Vertical Schools Policy Plan Amendment as directed by the Board of Supervisors.

Tyson’s Committee – Met on April 13th, June 16th, and June 30th to continue review of the proposed Draft Plan Text of the Tysons Plan Amendment.
