
A Snapshot of the Actions of the Fairfax County Planning Commission

Land Use Updates

The Planning Commission held 11 regular meetings during the Third Quarter of Fiscal Year 2016 (FY 2016) and acted on 45 applications.

The Providence District had the highest number of land-use actions, with 14 cases favorably recommended to the Board of Supervisors.
