



PLANNING COMMISSION SUMMARY OF ACTIONS

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The meeting was called to order at 8:15 p.m. by Vice Chairman John R. Byers.

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COMMISSION MATTERS

Commissioner Byers announced his intent to defer the decision only on RZ 2003-MV-060 and FDP 2003-MV-060, D. R. Horton, Inc., from July 29, 2005 to October 19, 2005.

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On behalf of Commissioner Alcorn, Commissioner Hart announced that on September 28, 2005 at 7:00 p.m., in Conference Rooms 2 and 3, the Environment Committee would host a public information session on the topic of drainage divides.

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Vice Chairman Byers stated that he had asked Commissioner Hart to draft up a brief addressing homeowners associations and preferential parking resulting from the recent Virginia Supreme Court decision in Sully Station II Community Association, Inc. v. Reginald W. Dye, et al.

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Commissioner Hart announced that public work sessions regarding the Zoning Ordinance Amendment resulting from the Virginia Supreme Court decision in Donald H. Cochran, et al. v. Fairfax County Board of Zoning Appeals would be held on:

Commissioner Hopkins seconded the motion which carried by a vote of 7-0-1 with Commissioner Harsel abstaining; Commissioners Alcorn, Lawrence, Murphy, and Wilson absent from the meeting.

Commissioner Lusk FURTHER MOVED THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT THE TRANSITIONAL SCREENING BE MODIFIED ALONG ALL BOUNDARIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH LANDSCAPING AND VEGETATION, AS SHOWN IN THE SE PLAT, AND THAT WE WAIVE THE BARRIER REQUIREMENT ALONG THE EASTERN, SOUTHERN, AND WESTERN BOUNDARIES AND THAT THE BARRIER BE MODIFIED ALONG THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY.

Commissioner Hart MOVED TO MAKE A FRIENDLY AMENDMENT TO THE DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONS AND CORRECT THE SPELLING OF "ASTERISK" ON PAGE ONE, FIRST PARAGRAPH.

Commissioner Hall accepted the amendment and the motion as amended carried by a vote of 7-0-1 with Commissioner Harsel abstaining; Commissioners Alcorn, Lawrence, Murphy, and Wilson absent from the meeting.

Commissioner Hall MOVED THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE REAFFIRMATION OF THE MODIFICATION TO THE TRANSITIONAL SCREENING

AND BARRIER REQUIREMENTS ON THE NORTHERN PROPERTY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL 29A AND A WAIVER OF THE TRANSITIONAL SCREENING AND BARRIER REQUIREMENTS ON THE EASTERN AND NORTHERN PROPERTY BOUNDARIES OF PARCEL 29; A MODIFICATION OF THE PERIPHERAL PARKING LOT LANDSCAPING ALONG ALL STREET FRONTAGES; A MODIFICATION OF THE TRAIL REQUIREMENT ALONG ROUTE 50 IN FAVOR OF THE EXISTING 4-FOOT WIDE SIDEWALK; A REAFFIRMATION OF A WAIVER OF THE SERVICE DRIVE REQUIREMENT ON ROUTE 7; A WAIVER OF FRONTAGE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG ROUTE 7, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISION OF ALL NECESSARY ANCILLARY MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS; AND FINALLY, OF A PARKING REDUCTION OF 20 PERCENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION A7-209 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

Commissioner Hall MOVED THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVAL OF REZONING 2005-MA-008, SUBJECT TO THE PROFFERS CONSISTENT WITH THOSE DATED SEPTEMBER 21, 2005.

Commissioner Hall MOVED THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVE THE FINAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2005-MA-008, SUBJECT TO FDP CONDITIONS DATED AUGUST 31, 2005 AND TO THE BOARD'S APPROVAL OF THE REZONING.

Commissioner Koch seconded the motion which carried by a vote of 7-0-1 with Commissioner Harsel abstaining; Commissioners Alcorn, Lawrence, Murphy, and Wilson absent from the meeting.

Commissioner Hall MOVED THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF A WAIVER OF THE SERVICE DRIVE ALONG ROUTE 7 AND OF INTERPARCEL ACCESS TO THE WEST; APPROVAL OF THE MODIFICATION OF LOADING SPACE REQUIREMENT FROM 5 SPACES TO 3 SPACES; APPROVAL OF THE MODIFICATION OF TRANSITIONAL SCREENING AND BARRIER AND OF THE BAILEY'S CROSSROADS STREETSCAPE REQUIREMENTS IN FAVOR OF THAT SHOWN ON THE CDP/FDP; AND FINALLY, A MODIFICATION OF THE TRAIL REQUIREMENT ON ROUTE 7 AND SOUTH GEORGE MASON DRIVE, IN FAVOR OF THE SIDEWALKS AND STREETSCAPE AS SHOWN ON THE CDP/FDP.

Commissioner Koch seconded the motion which carried by a vote of 7-0-1 with Commissioner Harsel abstaining; Commissioners Alcorn, Lawrence, Murphy, and Wilson absent from the meeting.
