ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT (ADVERTISING ON PUBLIC TRANSIT
PASSENGER SHELTERS)

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; recognize Mr. Alcorn.

Commissioner Alcorn: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. As we've heard in testimony tonight, there are some questions about the implementation of this and concerns about how it might be administered. So with that, Mr. Chairman, I would MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER DECISION ON THE PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT RELATING TO ADVERTISING ON PUBLIC TRANSIT PASSENGER SHELTERS, TO A DATE CERTAIN OF FEBRUARY 27, 2008.

Commissioner Hall: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Ms. Hall. Discussion? All those in favor of the motion to defer the decision only on Zoning Ordinance Amendment as it pertains to advertising on public transportation - - public transit passenger shelter signs, to a date certain of February 27th, with the record remaining open for comment, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Commissioner Sargeant: Mr. Chairman?

Chairman Murphy: Yes.

Commissioner Sargeant: Mr. Chairman, one question here. That may not be enough time, given that the South County Federation's Land Use Committee meets, I think on that date.

Commissioner Alcorn: Actually, I thought it was on the Tuesday.

Commissioner Sargeant: It's on the second Tuesday. Is that enough time?

Susan Fremit: It's on the last Tuesday of the month.

Commissioner Alcorn: Right, so that would be - - that would be the next day - -

Commissioner Sargeant: The next day.

Commissioner Alcorn: - - which should be fine.

Commissioner Sargeant: All right.

Chairman Murphy: Okay. All right. Caught right?

Commissioner Alcorn: Actually, two days.

Chairman Murphy: Okay. Motion passes - - carries.

Commissioner Alcorn: Two days.

Chairman Murphy: Thank you very much. Thanks for coming out. I appreciate it.

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(The motion carried unanimously with Commissioners Flanagan and Harsel absent from the meeting.)
