Chairman Murphy: Any final questions from the Planning Commission? If not, the public hearing is closed; recognize Mr. Alcorn.

Commissioner Alcorn: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. This is primarily an "oops" amendment as I like to call it. So, therefore, I would MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT REGARDING *STATE CODE*, EDITORIAL, AND MINOR REVISIONS, AS PRESENTED IN THE STAFF REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 16, 2010, WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF 12:01 A.M. ON THE DAY FOLLOWING ADOPTION.
