After the Close of the Public Hearing

Vice Chairman Alcorn: Public hearing is closed; recognize Commissioner Hall.

Commissioner Hall: Thank you. The moment I've been waiting for. Okay, I love my new toy. I took a photograph of all of you so I can show them at Mason District that you were here until ten minutes of 2:00. I'm sure you appreciate that. So that's one. I already told you that there was not going to be a decision this evening and, true to my word, there will not be a decision this evening. What I intend to do is make a motion to defer decision until March 8th for the record to remain open; also to remind you all to show up on 2/28 at Mason District at 7:30 p.m., because I know how much you all love to come to meetings, and I want to give you another opportunity to come to another one. I want to tell you how much I appreciate you all coming out this evening and I think it's a very positive comment about your community. I especially appreciate that you all didn't want to talk. No offense, but I think the people who did speak represented your community very well. And I also appreciate the input that I've gotten from my fellow Commissioners. They're always coming up with wonderful ideas. I also want to hear from Mr. Brown at some point the story about that - the Ford. And additionally, I want to thank the applicant because I believe they're trying very hard to work with the community. And I know that Lisa has worked tirelessly trying to get me out there because I retired and it's been a little bit crazy lately. So I think everybody's working hard.
