ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT – HOME CHILD CARE FACILITIES

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; recognize Mr. Hart.

Commissioner Hart: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Let me first thank all the speakers that came out this evening and all the folks that sent us letters and emails. I would like to also just briefly thank our staff, Cathy Belgin and Lorrie Kirst, for their very high-quality work on this important topic. I think we need a little more time to digest the comments we have received and reflect on our recommendation. Therefore, Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER DECISION ON THE PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT REGARDING HOME CHILD CARE FACILITIES TO A DATE CERTAIN OF APRIL 4, 2013, WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN FOR WRITTEN AND ELECTRONIC COMMENTS.
