After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; Mr. Lawrence, please.

Commissioner Lawrence: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. The thought that comes to mind is that Rome wasn't built in a day, and neither will Tysons be. But we saw tonight an application in which the end product achieves the Tysons vision as well as anything that I've seen since this thing started. And I think those survivors of the Task Force that are here will agree. We need, however, to finish what we all started out to do; and that is, get everything cleaned up so we can present a clean package to the Board. We'll take a look at the information we got this afternoon from the neighbor across the street and assess the consequence of what they had to say. It got too late - - got here too late for me to do anything with it, but we'll look at it during the period of deferral. And we thank the McLean Citizens Association for their thoughtful input. And with that, Mr. Chairman, I move - - and this is going to be a long one because of all the applications – I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER THE DECISION ONLY FOR PCA 92-P-001-09, PCA 92-P-001-10, RZ 2011-PR-010, RZ 2011-PR-011, FDP 2011-PR-011, AND FDP 2011-PR-011-02 UNTIL A DATE CERTAIN OF APRIL 3RD, 2013, WITH THE RECORD TO REMAIN OPEN FOR WRITTEN AND ELECTRONIC COMMENTS.

Commissioner Hart: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Hart. Is there a discussion of the motion? All those in favor of the motion to defer decision only on them there applications to a date certain of April 3rd, with the record remaining open for written comments or technological comments, say aye.
