Telecommunications Committee Recommendation on Radiofrequency (RF) Analysis

During Commission Matters

Chairman Murphy: I think everyone received a copy, either at the Telecommunications Committee or on the podium this evening, of the proposed motion to the Board of Supervisors that was ratified unanimously by the Planning Commission's Telecommunications Committee meeting this evening. And I'm not going into the rationale because you've all seen the copy of the rationale. Just the motion is, I'm going to MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT BASED ON THE AFOREMENTIONED RATIONALE, THE REQUEST INITIATED BY SUPERVISORS HYLAND AND HERRITY REQUIRING RF ANALYSIS, BE AMENDED TO INDICATE THAT WHILE THE BOARD SUPPORTS A PLANNING COMMISSIONER'S RIGHT TO SEEK AN INDEPENDENT RF ANALYSIS FROM THE APPLICANT, AND NOTES THAT APPLICANTS MAY PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION WITHOUT SOLICITATION TO INCLUDE WRITTEN AND/OR ORAL OR VISUAL AID INFORMATION, IT IS NOT A COUNTY REQUIREMENT.

Commissioner Lawrence: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Lawrence. Is there a discussion? All those in favor of the motion, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Murphy: Opposed? Motion carries. Thank you very much.
