SE 2012-PR-012 – TD BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; Mr. Lawrence.

Commissioner Lawrence: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Before I make a motion, I do want to say something. This deferral is going to be done without prejudice. I believe Mr. Taylor has responded adequately to the issues raised concerning traffic. On another topic altogether, I want to say a couple of things. Does anybody remember when the Valdez episode happened up in Alaska? Anybody remember when that was? Long time ago now, isn't it? What was it?

Commissioner Litzenberger: 1986. [*sic*]

Commissioner Lawrence: 1986. [*sic*] Well, moral imperatives affect different people different ways and they respond differently to these kinds - - what they see as moral imperatives. Since that episode, I have not bought one gallon of gas from that particular company, nor will I ever again. But that's how I personally dealt with that, and it was the only way I could deal with that. So I recognize that there are big moral issues here. And I say again, I wish we had a way of dealing with them, but we do not. We will deal with this on a land use basis. Mr. Chairman I MOVE THAT WE DEFER THE DECISION ONLY FOR SE 2012-PR-012 TO A DATE CERTAIN OF MAY 2ND, WITH THE RECORD TO REMAIN OPEN FOR ELECTRONIC AND WRITTEN COMMENTS.

Commissioner Hall: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Ms. Hall. Is there a discussion of the motion? All those in favor of the motion to defer decision only on SE 2012-PR-012 with the record remaining open for written comments, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Murphy: Opposed? Motion carries.
