SE 2007-DR-025 - MR. MOSTAFA AND DR. LILY NADIMI

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; recognize Mr. Donahue.

Commissioner Donahue: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Certainly a very interesting discussion this evening. I want to thank Mark Zetts for coming out and - - and getting the views of the McLean Citizens Association. [Zoning Ordinance Section] 9-610, it seems to me since I've been here, has been a fairly controversial ordinance. We had a hearing last week that Commissioner de la Fe commented on this evening and another one this evening. We'll get back to both of them in the future. Before we're done, I'm sure. But, I think what's obvious here is we worked with this Ordinance and in particular this application, is there are ideas, principles, interests that people hold very dear to heart and they're going to have to be dealt with, I suppose as some of these applications come to us. I think there are good points on both sides. I'm hoping in the next 14 to 21 days we can get to a solution that serves the interest of the most people. I don't - - I don't - - I don't pretend for a minute to think we are going to solve everybody's problems and interests in this issue, but we'll - - we'll do our best to get to a consensus. And with that, Mr. Chairman, I'D LIKE TO MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER THE DECISION ONLY FOR SE 2007-DR-025 TO A DATE CERTAIN OF MAY 28, 2009, WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN FOR FURTHER WRITTEN AND ELECTRONIC COMMENT.

Commissioners Alcorn and Sargeant: Second.
