During Commission Matters

Chairman Murphy: The first is an unusual one. It's a 2232 amendment to a 2232 that was approved for ball fields at the Willow Springs Elementary School. This week we learned that the SYA would like to host a state tournament for little league baseball and is requesting these fields, which had a cap on the illumination of the fields til 10:00 p.m. We are requesting, through this special application for a "feature shown," that for those three days only lights remain open til 11:00 p.m. because they need an extra hour for these kids to have their tournament. So, thanks to David Marshall and his people and the FMD, the Facilities Management Director, we were able to put forth this application today, and I would like to move that we – and this is an item, 2232A-S05-15, and I WOULD MOVE THAT THE PLANNING CONCUR WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ZONING AND FIND THE APPLICATION 2232A-S05 (*sic*) A "FEATURE SHOWN" OF THE ADOPTED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

Commissioner Lawrence: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Lawrence. Is there a discussion of the motion? All those in favor of the motion to concur with the motion, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Murphy: Opposed? Motion carries. And parenthetically, the neighbors in the vicinity who we negotiated the lighted fields with – with the lights going off at 10:00 p.m. will be notified in writing that for these three days they will be extended til 11:00 p.m. so the kids can have this tournament.
