FS-B11-3 – FIBERTOWER, 9525 Little River Turnpike

During Commission Matters

Commissioner Harsel: Mr. Chairman, I have a “Feature Shown Amendment” and a “Feature Shown”, both in the Braddock District. The first one is - - The first one is a “Feature-Shown-Braddock-11-3” - - it’s FiberTower at 9525 Little River Turnpike. This is a FiberTower on an existing monopole at Woodson High School. And I would like someone to please notify the Schools that their application was for 95 acres; therefore, they’re including the high school. So some of the little rent money should go to Woodson High School, which it hasn’t done before. This is also - - we have a new picture, so I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVE “FEATURE SHOWN” B11-3 because it’s a proposed telecommunication facility and it’s at Woodson High School and it goes with the new photos that came in, not the placement that - - not the photos in the staff report. They show a drawing in the staff report and they show a photo and they weren’t matching. So now we have the right photos to go with it. - - that in fact it IS A “FEATURE SHOWN” ACCORDING TO the Comprehensive Plan with 2232 – Section - - VA CODE SECTION 15-2.2232, AS AMENDED.
